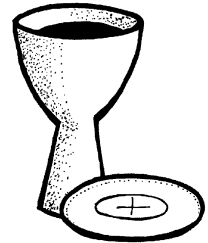
BODY & BLOOD OF CHRIST

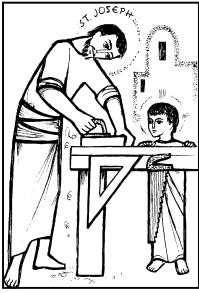
