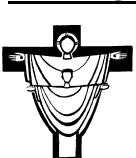

## **BEREAVEMENT MASS**

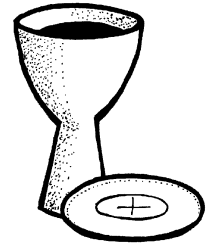
